The application deadlines for Erasmus students interested in studying at the Academy of Fine Arts "P. Vannucci" of Perugia are:

1st June 2025 (for the whole Academic Year and the Autumn Semester);

1st November 2025 (for the Spring Semester).

The procedure foresees a nomination letter sent by email by the Sending Institution and signed by the Institutional Erasmus Coordinator.

This nomination has to include the full names and surnames of the selected Erasmus students, their email addresses, the School/Department they are enrolled in and has to be sent to the following addresses: <u>direttoreamministrativo@abaperugia.org</u>, <u>erasmus@abaperugia.org</u>

The student will receive an email of acceptance within three weeks.

Once the student has been accepted, he/she has to complete the procedure via the OLA Online Learning Agreement platform: <u>https://learning-agreement.eu/</u> within one month of the acceptance email. Upon his/her arrival, the student will have two-weeks time to update, if necessary, the learning agreement.
